1. - What is so important about the quote from Harry S. Truman?  
- His quote is honoring the fallen veterans who served during World War II, though it can be applied to all veterans. He states that the sacrifices of the veterans will not be forgotten or in vain.
2. - World War II started when the Nazis invaded where?  
-Poland of 1939.
3. - Who won the battles at Normandy Landings?  
-Allies
4. -Who became president shortly after the Great Depression?  
-Franklin D. Roosevelt
5. -Does the number of deaths surprise you? How does it compare to World War I deaths of about seventeen-eighteen million people? Would you be even more shocked that some people consider it higher, some up to 80 million?  
-Open ended: It could be 1) Yes it did surprise me, or 2) No it did not surprise me. Anything is acceptable
6. -Now explain what the title of the webquest means.  
-The title is referring to the estimated number of deaths of World War II. The number is significant as it is one of the most brutal wars of modern history, and the number is a popular highlight of the war.
7. -Name the two political parties fighting for control in Germany before World War II and identify which one ended up taking all control.  
-National Socialist German Worker's Party (Nazi party) and the Communist Party. The Nazi party ended up taking control, as the Germans feared communism.
8. -What was World War I called, and why was it ironic?  
-Often called the world to end all wars. It is ironic as it was supposed to honor its name, however the opposite ended up happening, with the Treaty of Versailles and Hitler exploding into World War II with even more war and bloodshed than before.
